Note – as we walked through the Fair I felt her right hand holding my left, similar to the Picture on the Cover.

A year later and during the first week of September 2023 I again asked Erika if she would accompany me to the Fall Fair. She agreed and we toured through the fair grounds hand in hand. Once again I could feel her hand in mine as we walked together.

The next day I contacted her again by ITC and asked her “did you accompany me to the fall fair yesterday afternoon” and she answered “YES”.

When I asked her “is there any thing you would like to say”, she said “I HAVE A MISSION”.
